Rules for our event...

1. Applications for the 7th Annual Boss Hog Cook-off will be taken on a first-paid basis through April 27, 2012 with space limited to the first 42 teams.
2. Teams will be provided with: 20 x 40 space, water, electric, shared indoor restroom (not open to public) & shared indoor hospitality room.
3. Set-up will begin at 8 a.m. Friday, May 11th & must be completely set up by 3 p.m. Winners will be announced at 3 p.m. Saturday, May 12th & teams are asked to remain on site until gates close at 4 p.m. A fine of \$100.00 will be charged if a team leaves before 4 p.m.
**We encourage Thursday set up; however, sites will not be available until 1:00 p.m.*
4. All golf carts or recreational vehicles are prohibited from riding on the grassy center field of the Boss Hog Cook Off. All operators of golf carts or recreational vehicles must be 16 years of age or older.
5. Teams are to park in the gated lot to the left of the center field. Any other vehicles must use the public parking areas. Only one vehicle is allowed at each cook site.
6. Teams are encouraged to sell samples to the public, but are not allowed to sell drinks. Teams are expected to provide their own paper goods & money to make change for the public.
7. People's Choice participating teams must provide their own table, serving dishes & meat: two cooked, chopped & ready to serve pork butts by 10:30 a.m. on Saturday. DOOR will provide a volunteer, tablecloth, & paper goods throughout People's Choice tasting & voting (11 a.m.-2 p.m.).
**This is not a sanctioned event, feel free to be creative!*



The Anything Strawberry Competition held Friday, May 11th, is a free competition for all teams participating in the Boss Hog Cook-off. While cash prizes will be awarded, this portion of the cook-off is intended to be a fun, casual time for sponsors and judges to interact with team members. Please be sure to indicate on your team application that you are participating in the Anything Strawberry Competition.

General Guidelines...

8. A basket of fresh strawberries will be provided, free of charge, to each team along with their welcome bags.
9. Teams turn in entry at the KCBS turn-in station between 6:45pm and 6:55pm.
10. One serving per judge will be required and the number of judges is to be announced.
11. There are absolutely no rules for prepping and/or cooking.
12. DOOR will provide paper goods for judging.
13. Winners will be announced during the band's intermission.

1st Place - \$125 ● 2nd Place - \$50 ● 3rd Place - \$25



The King of the Wing, held Friday, May 11th, is a free competition for all teams participating in the Boss Hog Cook-off. While cash prizes will be awarded, this portion of the cook-off is intended to be a fun, casual time for sponsors, judges and the general public to interact with team members. Please be sure to indicate on your team application that you are participating in the King of the Wing competition.

General Guidelines...

1. A minimum of 10lbs of fresh chicken wings will be provided, free of charge, to each team.
2. Wings will be delivered to the teams between 3:00pm and 3:30pm on Friday, May 11th. You MUST be present at your cook site to receive your team's wings.
3. Teams turn in wings at the KCBS turn-in station between 6:15pm and 6:25pm.
4. One wing per judge will be required for turn in and the number of judges is to be announced.
5. There are absolutely no rules for prepping and/or cooking, so long as the wings remain at a safe temperature throughout the competition. We also do not mind garnishes or dipping sauces.
6. Teams are asked to distribute the remainder of wings to the public. DOOR will provide small paper containers for distribution.
7. Winners will be announced before the band performs.
